We constructed a training center where we had some of our training sessions. Our plan is to expand this center to a bigger size with office spaces.



RAINWATER HARVESTING TRAINING



We're grateful to our esteemed donor who supported us to train 150 vegetable farmers on rainwater harvesting for drought season drip irrigation farming. We will also equip them with small-size Rainwater Harvesting and Drip Irrigation Kits for drought-season farming on small farms. The training was planned to be in 3 batches, 50 per batch. We ended up training 55 farmers in the last quarter, but only fifty farmers will be equipped.
